LPP LETTER WRITING GUIDE

WHAT TO WRITE?

The biggest hurdle to beginning a pen pal relationship is getting started. A suggestion for a first letter might include an introduction along with a short bio, an explanation of how you came to hear about your pen pal, hobbies, pets, music, activism, etc. Let them know that cannabis justice activists like yourself are fighting for their freedom! Don't forget, the prison mail system can be slow. Sometimes it can take several weeks to get a response.

Here's some other ideas:

- Let the person you're writing to know you're fighting for them
- Let them know what's going on in your life as sometimes prisoners appreciate hearing stories and living through your stories
- Give them some updates on pop culture and things going on in your town
- Order them an online magazine subscription

MAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Plain White Envelopes Only

Please refrain from including anything but a postage stamp on the envelope. Adding stickers, tape, glue, glitter, staples, paper clips, fragrances, crayon, ribbon, or even address labels could cause the letter to be confiscated.

Content of the Letter

Refrain from including anything in your letter you wouldn't feel comfortable with DOC staff reading.

Take care not to include any drawings or markings that could be reasonably misconstrued as secret code or inappropriate content etc.

If you'd like to be written back please include your return address in the text of your letter as return address portion of the envelopes are cut off before they are given to the inmates.

Addressing the Envelope

Be sure to include your pen pal's full name, six-digit prison ID#, institution name, address. Your full name and return address must also be written on the envelope.

When Hector was tried for this offense in 2002, the first jury was not able to find him guilty and the trial ended with a hung jury. Federal prosecutors tried him a second time and he was convicted of this marijuana offense and was given a life sentence.

He remains hopeful that an executive clemency grant will reunite him with his family.



In 2006, a jury found Aaron guilty of one count of Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana and one count of engaging in a continuing criminal enterprise (CCE). While the CCE conviction was ultimately vacated, on January 24, 2007, Aaron was sentenced to life in prison for the marijuana charge.

About Parker:

Parker Coleman is currently serving a 60 year sentence for a victimless cannabis offense. Parker himself was never caught with any marijuana. In the entire case, only one person got caught with 26 pounds of weed and that one person was not even on Coleman's 21-person indictment. Out of those 21 people, Parker was only acquainted with 2 of them. At trial, no witnesses testified they had ever bought marijuana from Coleman. There was no violence involved in this case, although the police recovered 3 licensed guns from others in the case (who had concealed weapons permits). The guns did not belong to Coleman and he even passed a DNA test (with a 99% negative result) to prove that. Like others who take their cases to trial, as opposed to "cooperating" and testifying against others, Parker Coleman ended up with an extremely long sentence. Unless he receives clemency, he will be in his 80's by the time he is released from prison.

A message from Elliston:

"I was born in the Virgin Islands, where I remained until 1973, at which time I moved to Indiana, and returned to the Virgin Isles quite frequently. In 1978, I moved to San Diego, Ca., until 1982, I moved to Albuquerque, NM.

My immediate family is in Albuquerque, where I was Indicted for the conviction which I am still incarcerated, since 1992. I was Indicted by the State of New Mexico, and they dropped the charges 'picked up' the charges. With regard to the conviction for which I am confined to prison, the government said I Conspired to possess less than 50KG of Marijuana.

What actually happened:

I went to my Co-Defendant's house, knocked on the door, the Police opened the door and apprehended me, and I was carrying a 380 Pistol. My Co-Defendant said that he received the marijuana from me. The Police Officer that apprehended me, was under investigation at that time, and they arrested him, but did not indict him. "

"I grew up in Martinsville, VA and worked at Stanley furniture at the corporate office in the advertising and marketing department. I have two beautiful kids and a wonderful mother that's big on family tradition along with having unconditional love for one another.

The government charged me originally with possession with the intent to distribute marijuana along with two 924(c) on direct appeal, the second 924(c) was dismissed. I conducted a new sentencing report that made me a career offender due to prior offenses in state court. Those cases were part of the same investigation and occurred days apart - 2 sentences separately in two jurisdictions. I received a 30-year sentence and 18 years from the two prior marijuana offenses that deemed me a career offender. I originally served ten days and nine months for the two charges."





I have six children, four with my wife for whom I have known since childhood, and two from a previous relationship. I have practiced my faith since childhood and studied at a faith based school. I have held several jobs including a personal shopper for Instacart, an Uber driver, a telemarketer and as a laborer at Walmart. I am an avid helper with the youths at the boxing gym and with the second run at Fitness Wellness Group.

I was arrested and charged with conspiracy to distribute 1000/100 kilograms or more of marijuana and two counts of conspiracy to commit money laundering. At the time of the arrest I had left that life behind and was starting to make my life following the right path, becoming the man my kids could look up to and be proud of.

I've been incarcerated ten years now and i'm serving my sentence at FCI Latuna in Anthony, NM, a state where marijuana has been legalized.

Authorities from Oakland County, a notoriously anti-marijuana jurisdiction, pressed to prosecute Gammo, despite the fact he was accused of doing nothing different than dozens of other dispensaries operating in the wake of Michigan's 2008 medical marijuana legalization legislation.
